This week I finished my last MCCI pastor training session. As a reminder, Missional Church Consultation Initiative (MCCI) is an intensive



consultation and clergy coaching model designed to equip local churches for ministry relevant to their context. The unique thing about MCCI is that it is tailored to each individual church and it's a spiritual approach rather than traditional goal setting. For more than a year, the team consulting Bethany has been praying for our church. Our congregation has also been praying the Breakthrough prayer as a guide in this process. Rather than our own desires we are praying for God to show us what God desires for Bethany UMC.

A team of Bethany members has completed a detailed report of our ministries, staffing, history, demographics, membership information, and finances so that the consulting team assigned to Bethany will get an in depth understanding of Bethany. Now, it's almost time for our Express Day where that team will come meet with leaders and members to get input on our hopes and dreams for Bethany. Using this information, they will make recommendations specific to Bethany that our congregation will have the chance to review and vote on before moving forward.

## Simple Gifts for October — "Mujila Falls Agriculture Center"

Simple Gifts collected in October are going to support our longtime Global Mission Partners in the African nation of Zambia: the Mujila Falls Agriculture Center, which is led by Temba Nkomozepi.

Simple gifts are made by placing loose coins in the offering plates, or by putting cash or a check in mission envelopes. One can also give online by visiting BethanyMadison.org (click on We Serve and, from the drop-down menu, select Giving Financially).

Bethany has long supported the Mujila Falls Agriculture Center, where men and women of the Lunda tribe learn sustainable and appropriate methods for growing crops and managing livestock. People across a large area benefit from the eggs and plentiful food produced on the farm.

Mujila Falls has been in its current location since 2000 and was led for most of that time by Paul Webster. However, Webster returned to the United States in October 2018, and Mujila Falls for the past five years has been led by Nkomozepi, a missionary with the United Methodist General Board of Global Ministries.



Nkomozepi leads efforts in a range of agricultural, education, and health projects, as well as church growth and development. Mujila Falls raises essential crops, such as corn, and engages in small animal husbandry, cattle and goat milking, fruit culture, tree nurseries, fish culture, and research.

Nkomozepi will be visiting the Wisconsin Annual Conference from Oct. 17 to Nov. 6. He will also be visiting the Michigan Annual Conference, and Iowa.


In addition to creating employment opportunities for the youth, and contributing to rural development, Mujila Falls is currently in the process of constructing and establishing a rural training center that can educate numerous individuals. A ground-breaking ceremony for the training center was held with Webster earlier this year.

Nkomozepi is from Zimbabwe, where he received a BS degree in agriculture from the United Methodist-related Africa University in Mutare. He holds both a master's and PhD in agricultural civil engineering, with an emphasis on water resource management, from Kyungpook National University in Daegu, South Korea.

#### **TERRACYCLE PLASTIC COLLECTION**

#### **HEARING LOOP AT BETHANY!**

This new signage identifies an important addition at Bethany to improve the experience of worship for users of hearing aids.

T Hearing Loop

In 2019 Bethany added a Tele-coil hearing loop to the Sanctuary sound system. Hearing aid users who have a "T" coil in their aid(s) can now make a direct link to the audio system. This means that the hearing aid's

microphone does not have to pick up the sound from the loud speakers. The wearer can adjust the volume level with their own hearing aid controls for the loudness that they need. Hearing aid users may not be aware that their aid could have a "T" coil. It is an option that needs to be activated by their audiologist.


